

#### Behind The Zweig Letter Hot Firm 2007 List

> An explanation of how the 200 fastest-growing A/E/P and environmental consulting firms were determined.

How did these 200 firms get named to *The Zweig Letter* Hot Firm 2007 List? Not only did they survive economic instabilities over the past few years, but they grew in the process— some doubling or even tripling their gross revenue from 2003 to 2006. For the eighth year in a row, *The Zweig Letter* has ranked the fastest-growing architecture, engineering, and environmental consulting firms. We began the procedure for the list in January with a nationwide call for industry firms to complete a short entry form with questions about their firm type, size, and 2003 and 2006 gross revenues. Firm leaders from all types and sizes of companies shared this information with us. We received submissions from hundreds of firms exhibiting growth over the past three years, and then verified the top contenders' revenue figures using financial statements or income tax returns reviewed by third parties.

We created *The Zweig Letter* Hot Firm 2007 List to identify the fastest-growing architecture, engineering, planning, and environmental firms in the U.S. and Canada from 2003 to 2006. We had a limited number of Canadian entries, but are excited to have one within the top 200 this year. Congratulations to **R.F. Binnie & Associates** Ltd. (Burnaby, British Columbia) for being the first Canadian firm to be named a Hot Firm! After much competition for one of the top 100 spots over recent years, we adapted the 2007 list to recognize more firms for their accomplishments. The list doubled in size— from 100 firms last year to 200 this year— and we added 50 honorable mentions. We also recognized the top three firms in each of eight common firm types and listed the top 10 firms by size within each of three staff-size categories.

Eligibility rules for *The Zweig Letter* Hot Firm 2007 List state that firms must be based in the U.S. or Canada and derive the majority of their revenue from the practice of architecture, engineering, planning, environmental consulting, design and construction, or allied disciplines. Eligible firms had to be in business as of January 1, 2003, and had to have 2003 gross revenues of at least \$1 million. Since we first created the Hot Firm List in 2000, we've taken special care to recognize both small firms and large firms for their success. A \$5 million firm may have an easier time doubling in size than a \$5 billion firm, while, at the same time, growing by an additional \$1 billion is a more feasible goal for the large firm than the small firm. To alleviate this problem, we weighted firms' dollar growth and percentage growth equally to give both small firms and large firms an opportunity to make the list. Each firm was assigned a dollar ranking and a percentage ranking; then we combined the two numbers for a total score. The 200 firms with the best combined scores are the winners on The Zweig Letter Hot Firm 2007 List. The top 200 firms are of all types and sizes. Some are strictly architecture, engineering, or environmental consulting firms. Others are multi-discipline or full-service firms, offering a range of design and environmental services and, in some cases, project management and other services as well. Firms on this year's list range in size from \$2.6 million to \$900 million in 2006 revenue. And yet they all have one common characteristic— amazing growth over the past three years. The number-one firm on The Zweig Letter Hot Firm 2007 List is construction management firm TolTest, Inc. (Maumee, OH). E/A firm HDR, Inc. (Omaha, NE) had the highest dollar growth of all the firms, while A/E firm NELSON (Philadelphia, PA) grew the most on a percentage basis. Congratulations to all of this year's Hot Firms. We know it isn't easy to get to the top! And to those firms that didn't make it to this year's list, we look forward to giving you another opportunity to earn this recognition next year.—
